Options for moving on from Lansbury Bridge School and beyond will be discussed during your child's Education, Health and Care Plan Review meeting, and we endeavour to support you as much as we can in making your choice. Your child will also receive Careers Education, Advice and Guidance from Career Connect (previously Connexions) in school. Ann Kerry is our named advisor, and she works with groups of pupils and individuals.

As you can see from the table above, the majority of our pupils tend to move on to Mill Green College. From there, if they are still making academic or vocational progress, they may move on to Carmel College or St Helens College to further their education.

Most of our pupils choose to go to Mill Green when they leave Lansbury Bridge after Year 11. For the last 3 years, a number of pupils have also moved to Mill Green at the end of Key Stage 3; starting Year 10 at Mill Green. Please check the college website for more information.
